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What is HVIP?

Hybrid and Zero-Emission Truck and Bus Voucher Incentive Project

- **First-come, first-served vouchers** – Immediate discount at sale
- **Dealers learn voucher system** – Fewer complications for fleets
- **Set aside funding for each voucher** – Price certainty. No scrappage.
- New and retrofits; electric, hybrid, fuel cell, EPTO, Low-NOx natural gas
- 7,000 + vouchers, 1,000 fleets, 9 years



Waitlist Status

- As of **July 23, 2019**, all funds available for HVIP for Fiscal Year 18-19 have been requested, and a waitlist is in effect
- Vouchers can still be requested, however they will not be reviewed or approved until more funds are available
- Additional funds are anticipated to be available in **January 2020**
- The HVIP team suggests exploring other funding sources such as the Carl Moyer Memorial Air Quality Standards Attainment Program

Infrastructure Voucher Enhancements

- **Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment (EVSE):** Up to **\$30,000** per battery electric vehicle voucher
 - Covers hardware costs, load management software, energy storage
 - Does not cover labor or utility upgrade costs
- **H2 infrastructure:** Up to **\$100,000** for equipment cost for each fuel cell vehicle voucher; covers real costs of equipment
 - Must have at least 5 vehicle vouchers
 - Infrastructure cost can't be already covered by other public funding



Infrastructure Voucher Enhancements

- EVSE voucher enhancements must be requested within 60 days of the submittal of corresponding vehicle voucher requests. *If you have requested a vehicle voucher more than 60 days ago and still intend to request an EVSE enhancement, the deadline is August 31, 2019.*
- EVSE enhancement requests **cannot be submitted** if the corresponding vehicle voucher requests are on the **HVIP waitlist**.



First H2 Order in HVIP

SunLine Transit Agency deployed the first HVIP-funded hydrogen fuel cell buses this year.

SunLine's clean fleet includes over **75 alternative-fuel buses.**
